

CLEANING PROCEDURES (COVID-19)

Classrooms - each morning & each afternoon

- · Sanitize door knobs, light switches, hooks in the hallway, carpet, & sinks
- Sanitize chairs (including the back of the chairs), tables, edges and underside of tables
- · Sanitize high touch surfaces multiple times throughout the day
- · Sanitize tables before & after snack
- · Sanitize children's hands before & after snack (soap and water)
- · Sanitize children's hands before & after playtime (teacher must give out sanitizer)
- · Sanitize toys throughout the day, rotate toys the children play with during the day
- · Sanitize pencil boxes, crayon cups ~ all high touch items must be sanitized
- · Sanitize toys each day

Arrival of children

- Sanitize book bag & folders
- Sanitize coats
- · Sanitize hands before entering classroom (teacher must give out sanitizer)

Classrooms

- Children will be contained in their classrooms except to travel to the restrooms and playground.
- Children coming from the church building to the playground will walk across the bridge and down the back stairwell to the sidewalk on Salbide Avenue to get to the playground.

Restrooms

- · All children must be accompanied to restroom
- Sanitize after each child ~ toilet, door knobs, sink area, soap dispenser, paper towel dispenser
- · No groups of children in the restroom or waiting outside the restroom in the hallways

Playtime*

- Upstairs toys will be limited and sanitized regularly throughout the day
- Children will sanitize their hands after leaving the playground or upstairs paly area
- *Update July 28, 2020 classes will play outside every day unless it is raining or too cold.

Specials Classes*

- Children will sanitize hands upon entering/leaving classroom
- Teacher will sanitize floor and other high-touch surfaces between classes and during class, if necessary

*Update July 28, 2020- children will remain in their classrooms. Specials teachers will travel to the classrooms until further notice.

Masks

- Children are not required to wear masks
- Staff will wear masks at carpool, in hallways and any time of close contact with a child or staff member

Diagnosed Case of Covid-19

• If we learn of a diagnosed case in one of the classrooms, that person will need to have a doctor's note to return to the school. Parents will be notified. The classroom will be totally disinfected before anyone occupies it again.
